10. Burials: Discussion and agreement to resolutions, following circulation of documentation:

10.1. New Burials

- To support continued long term provision for 'full' burials within Blockley Parish
- To approve research into options including re-use of the Lower Cemetery and acquisition of a new burial site
- To approve cessation of all future interments (full burials and cremated remains) in the Lower Cemetery (north side)

10.2. Memorial Inspection

- To approve the Burial Ground Maintenance, Safety, Inspection & Repair Policy 2015
- To approve Cemetery memorial safety inspection commencing July 2015 (subject to faculty)
- To approve Churchyard memorial safety inspection commencing August 2015 (subject to faculty)
- To approve purchase of 10 steel posts and plastic netting (to stabilise unsafe memorials)
 - Metal fencing pins x 10 (Premier Barriers) - £17.39
 - Green barrier fence 50x1m (Premier Barriers) - £24.72
